These shows address the troubling issue of teen suicide. Local teens perform and develop these shows under professional direction. The directors are West High School Drama Teacher, Myra Nurre and international director and actress, Jane Lind in collaboration with Plains Indian sign language instructor, Ron Garritson. Each performance concludes with a Q&A to get audiences talking about mental health and suicide, and prevention resources.

"I wanted to show there's a way out. You don't have to suffer in silence," said **Let's Talk Billings** teen performer, **Jonathan Walters**.

The Let's Talk Billings project empowers Billings teens to speak up about youth depression and suicide. It's a project of Global Health Equity Foundation (GHEF) and is co-sponsored by the Montana IDeA Networks of Biomedical Research Excellence (INBRE).
